Cheat Sheet

Take a moment to ensure you understand each of the key points below... if not, go back and listen to the training:

□ Be ready for any of the below potential elements that could appear during auditions:

- Introduction (Intro) Speech & Speaking Ability
- Freestyle/Fillers and/or Solo Routine
- Dance Routines (Style; How quickly you pick up the dance; Retention of moves Performance; Facials, etc.)
- Dance Technique and Kicks/Flexibility
- Modeling/Walking the Runway/Photo Shoot
- Interviews (Responses; Speaking Ability; Personality; etc.)
- $\hfill \square$ Understand what the Judges are looking for during each of the above elements.
- □ Be mindful of all of the below potential scoring elements:
 - Overall Appearance / Look
 - Dance Ability/Execution, Technique, and Kicks
 - Showmanship & Personality
 - Well Rounded (Professional & Personal) and Versatile (Dance & Look)
 - Confidence & Coach-ability
 - Work Ethic & Willingness to Learn
- □ Review ALL the Audition Tips and jot down any that stand out to you.
 - 1. Arrival to Auditions
 - 2. During Auditions
 - 3. While Learning Choreography
 - 4. While "On Deck"... Getting Ready to go in front of the Judges
 - 5. Presentation As you walk in & exit and as you stand in front of the Judges
 - 6. As You Dance
 - 7. During Downtime/Breaks
 - 8. During Announcements/Cuts
- □ Be EARLY... not just on time for prep classes, workshops, and especially auditions!
- □ Be SMART by knowing and acting on the Audition Tips and having fun at auditions!!

FINAL POINT:

Being successful at an audition is far more involved that just showing up and performing. There are inside tips and secrets that will make you a "Smarter" Candidate... be sure to know them and act on them!
